**Groesbeck Parham, MD.,** earned his B.S. degree from Oberlin College and his M.D. degree from the University of Alabama at Birmingham. He is a professor of gynecologic oncology at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. Dr. Parham founded the Cervical Cancer Prevention Program in Zambia, South Africa, where he lives.
